There were enough interested people and it was decided to establish a new combined club named Ringwood Clocktower Probus Club.

The first general meeting was held at the Ringwood RSL on May 16th under the inaugural president Anne Oughtbridge.

Numbers have grown from an initial 111 members to 150 which is our current ceiling. These members are involved in the 30 interest groups which range from Bocce to Walking.

To keep numbers up to date with current and coming activities there is a vibrant and informative newsletter 'Clocking On' as well as our annual Calendar which is produced by the Digital Photography interest group..
